



A. Participation Requirements:

1. Must be a member of Kentucky Walking Horse Association
2. Must pay a nominating fee
3. Ask Breeders Association to Identify Kentucky Foals
4. To be Kentucky bred; Foals must be born in Kentucky. Mare must be in state 45 days prior to foaling
5. Points will only count for affiliated shows in Kentucky

B. How to earn points

All points will be earned by showing at affiliated shows in Kentucky. One point will be allowed when a qualified nominated foal shows in a halter class and any nominated foal showing under saddle will be awarded two points. All nominated horses showing will receive their earned points once they have completed their class. Any horse that excuses himself or is excused by the show management will result in loss of their points. Nominated show horses may only show and receive points within a 24-hour time frame. Multiple shows can result in several points if shown in a 24-hour stretch. Show application must be submitted at the end of the show season with all points and shows attended to be granted points.

C. Nominated foals can earn double points by showing at the Kentucky Celebration.

D. Distributions of Funds

With 100% being total money

1. 5% being held for Breeders Incentive Horse Show
2. 10% to stallions standing in Kentucky (\$\$\$\$ divided by number of stallions=\$\$\$)
3. 25% to mares nominated (\$\$\$ divided by number of mares=\$\$\$)
4. 60% to foals foaled in Kentucky (\$\$\$ per point earned by showing divided by number of horses=\$\$\$)

The above POINTS EARNED FROM SHOWING will reflect back to the mare and stallion

G. Nomination fees are as follows	Stallions	\$50.00/ per year
	Mares	\$50.00 one time fee
	Weanlings	\$50.00 one time fee (If stallion is nominated) \$100.00 (If stallion is not nominated)
	Yearlings	\$750.00 one time fee
	2 Year olds	\$1250.00 one time fee

H. Deadline for nomination is June 1<sup>st</sup>. All nominations after June 1<sup>st</sup> will count towards the following year's show season. Weanlings have 1 full year to nominate from birth date. Any weanling that is planning on showing as a weanling will have 60 days from date of birth to nominate if they want to show in the current show season after the June 1<sup>st</sup> deadline.

I. 15 years of age is the cut off for funding. This only applies to showing foals. Mares and Stallions will be exempt.

J. "Any attempt in connection with the Kentucky Walking Horse Breeders Incentive Fund to provide false or misleading information to KY breed affiliates or government officials, or to otherwise engage in fraudulent activity, shall result in appropriate disciplinary action by the Kentucky Walking Horse Breeders Incentive Fund and the application of all administrative, civil and criminal penalties that may apply." Any owner/trainer who is caught nominating doing so will be banned for life from the Kentucky Walking Horse Breeders Incentive Program and reported to the State of Kentucky.
